General Instructions

- 1. Time limit : Should not exceed more than 2 minutes .**
- 2. Date of submission of all videos is Tuesday, 20th October, 2020.**
- 3. All schools must adhere to the rules set for each event .**
- 4. All correspondence should be mailed to lerecofest2020@gmail.com**
- 5. A Whatsapp group will be created with the two teacher representatives of each school to facilitate easier communication.**
- 6. On the day of the fest, participants of the live event should report 20 minutes prior to the commencement of the fest.**
- 7. All participants are requested to stay online till the end of the fest.**
- 8. During the events, the audience is requested not to present the screen or type in the chat box. They are also requested to keep their audios muted and videos off.**



1. Name of the event: Recite to Preserve- Poetry (Live Event)

4. Guidelines for the Event:

- a. The poem should be the participant's original composition .
- b. The poem can be recited either in English or in the vernacular.
- c. The student should be dressed in a costume that reflects the poem she/he is reciting.
- d. Props may be used if required.
- e. Students to create an artificial background in accordance with their poem.
- f. Before reciting the poem , the student should introduce herself/himself mentioning the following:

Guidelines for the Event:-

The video will have **three** main parts to it:-

1. **Introduction**: The student needs to introduce herself/himself and the school she/he is representing

- The student needs to wear her/his school uniform while doing so.
- She/he needs to give a brief account about the material/materials used to design her/his costume and the accessories.

2. **The Walk**: The student will walk displaying her/his designer costume with a background music to give an extraordinary effect to her/his presentation .(can be creative)

3. **Message** : The student needs to click a picture wearing her/his costume and will have to make a slide with the message that she/he wants to give .

The material to be used for the costume will be assigned to each school through a lottery system.

3. No. of participants: 1 per school.

4. Guidelines for the Event:

- a. The student will be dressed in her/his school uniform .
- b. The participant is required to record her/his video preferably in a garden, veranda or on a terrace with plants around.
- c. At the beginning of the recording, the participant, while introducing herself/himself should hold up an A4 sized placard with the following details-
